## **RECOMMENDED USB TO SERIAL ADAPTER For Windows 98-ME-NT-2000-XP Not VISTA**

A lot of today's newer PC Computers (especially notebooks) do not have the DB-9 Pin Serial connector available anymore. These have been replaced with USB connectors. You still need a serial connector to connect to the Field Controller for downloading of the data table and for connection to the Pyrodigital Time Code Modem or the SMPTE Modem.

Not all USB to Serial adapters are the same. Most DON'T WORK properly because they have too long of a data buffer which results in erratic behavior in Show Director when using Pyrodigital Time Code. Downloading problems to the Field Controller have also been seen.

Preferred and recommended USB to Serial Adapter is

Also be sure to get Serial Adapter 9 pin female D-sub to DB25 male. (needed to convert the 9 pin Serial Adapter to DB 25 pin for downloading to the Field Controller or connection to the Pyrodigital Time Code Modem)
